



TITANIUM PICNIC SUN SHADE



SUN SHADE ASSEMBLY

1. Lay the canopy flat on the ground, keeping the yellow/orange pole tunnels visible on the top. See figure 1.
2. Extend and connect the poles. Thread the poles through the yellow/orange tunnels, end cap first, starting at the ring pin end of the longer tunnel. Cross the pole through the center point loop on the canopy and enter the tunnel directly opposite. The pole will come to a stop at the pole pocket. See figures 2-4.

3. Taking both ends of one pole, bow until an arch is made, then insert the pin into the end of the pole to retain curve. Repeat steps 2 and 3 with the other two poles. Several attempts may be necessary in order to stretch the material into position. Don't be afraid to use a little force. See figure 5.
4. Adjust the tension straps as needed. Lengthen/loosen them to achieve less height and more ground cover; shorten/tighten them to give more height and less floor cover. See figure 6.
5. Fill the included pockets with sand, earth or stones to keep the shelter in place. In windy conditions, the guy ropes and stakes may be used for extra stability. See figures 7 and 8.

CARE

To clean: Brush off excess sand, hose down with fresh water or wipe with a wet sponge. Do not use detergent. Air dry.

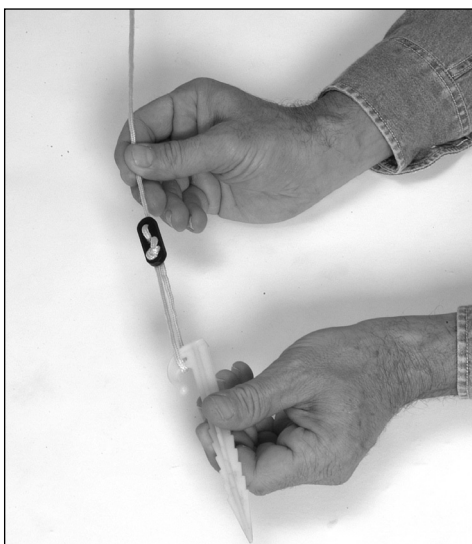
